

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR VISITORS

Start Date: 01 May 2022

In accordance with the announcement made by the Health Minister on 27 April 2022 on the relaxed Covid-19 SOP starting 01 May 2022, please find the updated SOP below:

GENERAL RULES:

- 1) MySejahtera check-ins are **no longer required** for entering the campus.
- 2) Officer-in-charge are responsible to forward visitor details to FMP latest **by 5.00 pm at least a day before** entering the campus.
- 3) Entry to campus is allowed regardless of vaccination status.
- 4) Individuals with MySejahtera status of **'High Risk'** or under the **'Home Surveillance Order'** (HSO) will **not be allowed to enter** the campus. Visitors are to show the security guards their MySejahtera status before entering the campus.
- 5) The wearing of face masks is **required indoors**, but not required outdoors. However, it is "strongly encouraged". Mask wearing is still encouraged in crowded outdoor areas and for high-risk individuals.
- 6) Physical distancing is encouraged but no longer mandatory.

Mask-wearing will be optional in outdoor settings

Mask-wearing is still encouraged in crowded outdoor areas and for high-risk individuals

Mask can be removed indoors in certain situations such as when eating, when exercising alone, when giving a speech or when performing on stage
